



## Covid -19 Catch Up Premium

### Overview

Bolder has been allocated a provisional sum of £26,480 for 331 students as part of Covid-19. It is expected that the Academy may receive a final allocation of £40,000 once the figures are adjusted for actual students numbers from the Census.

### Strategy - Academic Year 2020-2021

With over 30% of the student population without access to computers the Academy has spent £26,000 on buying 100 Chromebooks. These Chromebooks are used when students need to self isolate or when they need to access online learning. The intended impact is that students will be able to make progress with their learning throughout the period of the pandemic.



Furthermore, any additional funds received will be allocated to:

- Supporting additional interventions on a rolling basis to target specific students with specific needs. Currently, independent study (homework), EAL and Maths catch up are priorities. These are detailed in the Academy's provision mapping.
- Increasing the provision of staffing / coaches to support with students' social times. This will support the behaviours during lunchtime and in turn, support learning during lessons.
- Increasing counselling provision.
